2004 Annual Fisheries Statistics Report

Introduction.

This report briefly summarizes the 2004 annual figures for fisheries commercial export, home consumption, fish catch, imports, company local purchase records and the number of fish export establishment licenses issued.

Commercial Exports.

Fisheries commercial export is centered around inshore commercial resources such as trochus (*Trochus niloticus*), sea cucumber (*holothuria* spp.), giant clams (*Tridacna* spp.) and marine aquarium trade. In 2004, marine aquarium trade has become a major fisheries export product (Table 1).

Trochus (*Trochus niloticus*)




Figure 1: Trochus Annual Export Production.

Trochus shell export comes under three semi-processed categories. These include button blanks, shell rims and scraps. These are exported primarily to China and Hong Kong. The semi- processed button blanks will be further processed and use for high quality clothing and the rims and scraps are mostly used for souvenirs, designs and inlay works. The total trochus export for 2004 is 35 tons with a total value of approximately 35 million vatu (Table 1& Fig. 1).

Beche-de-mer




Figure 2: Beche-de-mer Annual Export Production.

Beche-de-mer is a dried product of sea cucumber. Sea cucumber is a non- traditional resource therefore is not consumed locally. However it is a delicacy in Asian countries and all beche-de-mer export is destine for the Asian markets, particularly in China and Hong Kong. 2004 total beche-de-mer export is 14 tons with a total approximate value of nearly 14 million vatu (Table 1 & Fig. 2).

Giant clams

Giant clam export is primarily for aquarium purposes and is exported live mostly to the USA. 2004 clam export has a 21% decrease from 2003 total exports with a total value of Vt687,880 (Table 1 & 10). The decrease is due to the current policy on wild harvest for export of some giant clam species.

Marine Aquarium Trade

Marine aquarium trade is the harvest, keeping and trade of live fish, corals, live rocks and various invertebrates such as giant clams, seastar, shells and shrimps.

Aquarium Fish

There are over 300 aquarium fish species exported from Vanuatu for aquarium trade. These are mostly exported to USA, Europe, Asia and Australia. The total number of fish exported in 2004 is approximately 70,000 pieces with the approximate value of 12 million vatu (Table 1).

Hard Corals, Soft corals, Live Rock & Invertebrates

Coral exported are primarily cultured corals. This is due the current ban of wild harvest of coral for export. The total number of cultured corals exported in 2004 is 30 pieces a very significant decrease from the total number exported in 2003 which is 2185 pieces (Table 1 & 10).

Total soft coral exported in 2004 is 40 pieces with an approximate value of 18,560 vatu (Table 1 & 10).

The total live rock export for 2004 is 56 tons with an approximate value of 4.5 million vatu (Table 1 & Fig. 6).

Various invertebrates species exported in 2004 include seastar, sea urchin, shrimps and octopus. The total number exported is 3,791 pieces with the approximate value of 188,790 vatu (Table 1 & Fig.10).

Fish Export

Fish exported is primarily to Australia with a total quantity of 500 kg and an approximate value of 350,000 vatu. The quantity of fish exported is usually limited due to high local demand for the particular fish species that's being exported (Table 1 & Fig. 4).

*Green snail (*Turbo marmoratus*)*




Figure 3: Green Snail Annual Export Production.

The total quantity of green snail exported in 2004 is 227 kg with an approximate value of 131,660 vatu. A significantly small quantity of exported due to the continuous declining stock of the resource in archipelago (Table 10 & Fig. 3).

Shark Fin

The total shark fin exported in 2004 is 48 kg with an approximate value of 161,472 vatu (Table 1 & Fig. 7).

Home Consumption

Home consumption or private exports are fisheries products that people travel with for the purpose of home consumption. Various fisheries products for home consumption include coconut crab (*Birgus latro*), rock lobsters, fish, beche-de-mer, shark fin and fresh water prawns. Refer to table 2 for home consumption figures for 2004.

Imports

Fisheries import permit is issued both for private and commercial purposes. In 2004, 23 fisheries import permits were issued for various fisheries products including fish, prawns, mussels and trochus. The total import quantity in 2004 is about 19 tons with trochus accounting for 98% of the total import. Refer to table 3 for the total import figures.

Fish Catch

2004 fish catch is principally for local commercial and artisanal fishing activity. The commercial fishing can be further categorized into bottom longline and pelagic longline fishing activities.

Commercial Fishing

Bottom Longline Fish Catch

The bottom longline fish catch for 2004 is about 12 tons. The short red tail poulet (*Etelis carbonculus*) and the long tail red poulet (*Etelis coruscans*) account for the bulk of the total bottom longline fish catch. Table 4 shows the bottom longline fishing catch.

Pelagic Longline Catch

The total 2004 pelagic longline fish catch is about 1.6 tons. A variety of pelagic commercial species are caught including tuna, marlin and skipjack. Table 5 shows the total catch.

Artisanal Fish Catch

The total artisanal fish catch for 2004 is about 19 tons with the approximate value of nearly 8 million valu. The bottom fish species made up the bulk of the fish quantity with over 70% followed by the pelagic species and reef fish species. Table 6 shows the total 2004 artisanal fishing catch.

Fish Market Production

A total of 22 tons of fish was purchase by 5 fish markets in 2004 worth of approximately 4.9 million valu. The fish species includes various commercial species of pelagic, deep bottom and reef fish species (Table 7).

Company Local Purchase Records

A total of 120 tons worth of 26 million valu of various inshore species purchase by four companies throughout Vanuatu. These species includes trochus, beche-de-mer, green snail, MOP, Turban shell and shark fin. Refer to table 8 for the company local purchase records.

Fish Export Establishment Licenses

A total of 21 Fish Export Establishment Licenses were issued to 10 companies in 2004. The licenses issued includes beche-de-mer, Trochus, Aquarium fish, live rock, invertebrates, shark fin, Pen shell, turban shell, mop shell, cultured corals, giant clams and fresh water eels. Out of the 20 licenses issued, 6 were beche-de-mer licenses and 3 live rock license, others products have 1 each. Table 9 shows the total number of licenses for each companies and products.




Figure 4: Fish Annual Export Production.




Figure 5: Lobster Annual Export Production.




Figure 6: Live Rock Annual Export Production.




Figure 7: Shark Fin Annual Export Production.




Figure 8: Marine Aquarium Fish Export Production.




Figure 9: Giant Clam Annual Export Production.




Figure 10: Invertebrates Annual Export Production.




Figure 11: Cultured Coral Annual Export Production.
