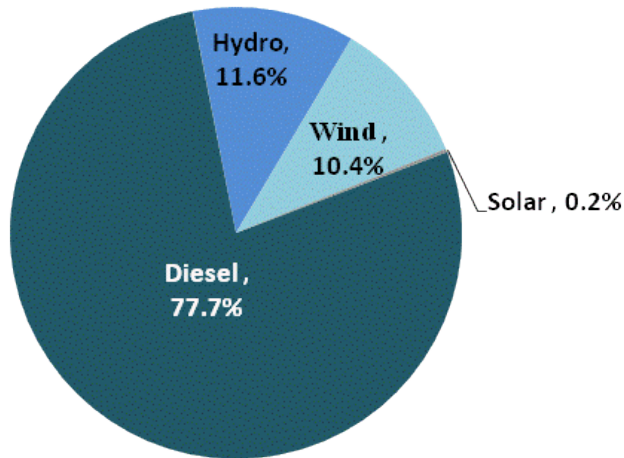

MONTHLY ENERGY MARKET SNAPSHOT FOR July 2014



Electricity sources – Jul 14

The chart on the left shows how electricity was produced in Vanuatu in July. 77.7% was generated from Diesel, followed by Hydro 11.6%. Wind contributed for 10.4% and Solar generated an additional 0.2%.

Electricity generation by area – Jul 14

The following table shows the quantity of diesel used to generate electricity and the total amount of electricity generated for the month in each area. The table also indicates the contribution of the different energy sources to the total electricity generated per area this month.

Fuel and energy price index evolution

This table compares the monthly change of the fuel price index, litres used and the electricity price index in Vanuatu. Both indexes for fuel cost and electricity price started with 100pt base in June 2011.
